MAINTENANCE REPORT FOR JUNE 2019

Since the last report we have completed the upgrade and maintenance of the fire extinguishers throughout the Church, Hall, Lovat Chapel and Hartigan Centre. This work was overdue and all extinguishers were replaced due to all being out of date. This is a 6 month program and should only need inspections over the next 5 years for which the Parish has signed up.

As well, Emergency Signs and lighting has also been carried out with the first stage, the Hall, done. The Church and Hartigan Centre inspections should be carried out over the next 2 months. This also will be a 6 month program and once the signs, if needed are replaced then they too should satisfy compliance for the next 5 years.

Neither of these maintenance issues were budgeted for and will cause other works to be put on hold for the time being.

If you wonder why such work is required the Archdiocese Insurance requires all safety measures are implemented. We have to sign off on all aspects of Risk and Safety to protect all parishioners and our buildings.

The Gym classes are going ahead with great outcomes and are very happy with their new location in the hall. I have given them the OK to install rings for parts of their program; the rings will be hung from one of the large beams under the ceiling. No damage will occur to property.

The Chapel and Hartigan have a busy month with a retreat on Saturday 15th 12.30 to 5pm, Sunday 23rd Interfaith Talk at 2.30 pm, and 30th Organ Concert with Trumpets at 2.30pm.

Of course there are still lots of outstanding maintenance works to be carried out and this will occur when funds are made available.
