Still no change from previous meeting

Liturgies currently continuing with allowing 100 parishioners plus helpers. Have been averaging around 60 – 70 at each Mass. We have used the choir for when extra parishioners attend, such as a commitment Mass.

We are continuing to get people to sign in when they come to Mass and get phone numbers for those who come from out of town.

Seats are being wiped down before each weekend Mass, every 2nd seat to remain tapped off. Sanitiser provided for all to use as they walk in.

Registered as a COVID safe environment and need to keep all restrictions in place.

Eucharist: Still no visits to the homes, Special Ministers have kept in touch with those willing to be called each Sunday. This is now listed in the roster

We call them around the same time, approx. 9:00 and have a chat, read the Sunday Gospel, and say other prayers with them. It has been good to keep in touch and lets them know they are not forgotten
